# SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

*Your safety is our top priority. Before installing and using this equipment, please read and follow these important warnings and guidelines:*

- 1. Make sure there is enough space between the wall, cabinet, and ceiling. Don't completely seal off the back of the cabinet; provide an air vent to the outside. Caution: Maintain a distance of more than 8 inches from the cabinet to the wall.**
- 2. Remove all external packaging materials to prevent overheating and the risk of fire.**
- 3. Do not store flammable or volatile chemicals, as they may lead to explosions.**
- 4. Use individual single-phase outlets, ensuring a reliable connection to a grounding wire. Caution: Do not connect the grounding wire to a water or gas pipe.**
- 5. During transportation, avoid harsh collisions or excessive vibrations; the cabinet should not be inclined beyond 45 degrees.**
- 6. Consult the Troubleshooting guide if the unit experiences issues. Do not attempt to resolve problems yourself; seek assistance from a certified technician.**
- 7. DANGER: Risk of fire or explosion due to flammable refrigerant. Do not use mechanical devices to defrost the refrigerator, and do not puncture the refrigerant tubing.**
- 8. DANGER: Risk of fire or explosion due to flammable refrigerant. Repairs should only be carried out by trained service personnel. Do not puncture the refrigerant tubing.**
- 9. CAUTION: Risk of fire or explosion due to flammable refrigerant. Refer to the repair manual or owner's guide before attempting to service this product. Adhere to all safety precautions.**

- 12. CAUTION: Keep all ventilation openings in the appliance enclosure or building structure free from obstructions.**
- 13. CAUTION: Servicing should be performed by factory-authorized service personnel to minimize the risk of ignition caused by incorrect parts or improper service.**

## ATTENTION

*It's crucial to adhere to the following safety guidelines. Neglecting these instructions may result in severe injury or damage to the appliance.*

- Ensure the appliance is connected to a dedicated outlet to prevent electrical overload and potential fire hazards.**
- Avoid the use of extension cords.**
- When needing to move the appliance, do not place your hands underneath it.**
- If the appliance will not be in use for an extended duration, disconnect it from the power source.**

- After unplugging the appliance, allow a minimum of 10 minutes before reconnecting it to prevent compressor damage.

## UNPLUGGING PROCEDURES

- Always ensure your hands are dry when handling the power cord to prevent electrical shocks.
- Prior to any maintenance or cleaning activities, disconnect the appliance from the power source.

## GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

For safety reasons, ensure the appliance is correctly grounded to prevent potential electrical hazards.

## PROHIBITED ACTIONS

- Do not attempt to dismantle or repair any components unless explicitly directed by the manufacturer.
- Ensure the appliance is positioned in a manner that doesn't put pressure on the electrical cord or plug.
- Avoid hanging or placing excessive weight on the appliance doors to prevent personal injury.
- The appliance is not designed to store flammable or explosive substances. Keep such materials away.
- Tampering with or altering the electrical cord is strictly prohibited.
